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PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION WILL IMPACT TRAFFIC ON LOS CORDOVAS AND BLUEBERRY HILL ROADS

TAOS – New Mexico Gas Company is enhancing the safety of its pipeline system in Taos, and motorists need to be aware of two upcoming construction projects that will cause traffic delays.

Blueberry Hill Road will be closed in both directions from May 5 until May 16 between State Road 240 and Cottom Road, with barricades in place north of Arroyo Park Drive. Local residents will have access but are asked to drive slowly and follow directional signs.

From May 27 until June 7, there will be one-way traffic with temporary traffic lights operating along Los Cordovas Road west of State Road 240.

Motorists traveling through the construction zones are asked to slow down, watch for message boards with traffic updates and follow directions on posted signs. New Mexico Gas Company thanks you for your patience as we make investments to keep you safe.
